Time to Talk Meetings

Half-Termly Nappy Charge

We always have a number of children that are at varying stages of potty training when they first start with us. Some children are still in nappies and this is fine. However, we realise finding nappies etc. from children's bags to change the children takes staff a considerable time. To make things easier, we purchase the nappies and keep them all in one central changing area. To cover costs, we will invoice parents of children in nappies a nominal fee of 40p per session. This additional charge will be added to your next fortnightly invoice which will be sent on Friday 20th October.

Charges for Wraparound

After half term, we will be making some changes to how wraparound is charged for in line with our Charging Policy. For breakfast club and the first and second hour after school club, one month's notice will be required to cancel these sessions. If your child has these sessions booked as part of their regular booking pattern and does not use them, charges will still apply on your invoice. Charges will apply if your child is unwell. If the wraparound is part of your 30 hours funding, no charges will be made. For further information, a copy of our charging policy is attached to this newsletter.

Auditing of Accounts

The school holds a private bank account which holds funds to provide additional materials and opportunities to enhance experiences for our children. This fund is used to purchase items above those provided for by the schools delegated budget e.g. private fund raising for specific items.
