An accident slip will then be sent home with your child with details of how the bump occurred and any treatment given. Emails

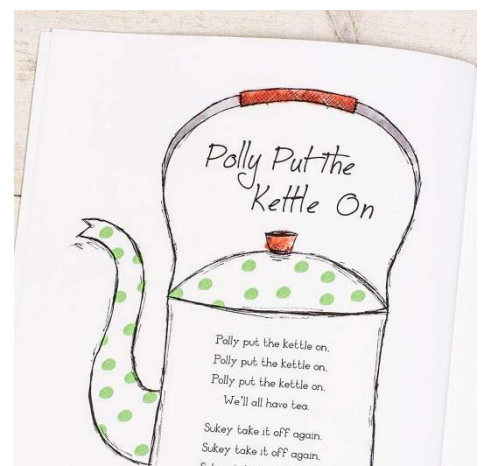
