Funding

If you are in receipt of the 30 hours extended funding for your child, every three months you will need to reconfirm you are still eligible. You'll be reminded to reconfirm you're still eligible 4 weeks before the deadline by HMRC. If you also receive Tax-Free Childcare, you'll be able to reconfirm your eligibility for both schemes at the same time. You don't need to provide us with your code each time you reconfirm however; you should notify us if you fall out of eligibility. If you don't reconfirm, us and the local authority will be told that you no longer meet the requirements for a free childcare place. If you're no longer eligible, you can still access the 15-hour universal early education entitlement for 3 and 4-year-olds.

Headlice
