Lunchtimes at Truro Nursery School

Many of our children stay for lunch whilst at Truro Nursery and we want this to be an enjoyable time for them.

DUE TO NUT ALLERGIES - PLEASE DO NOT INCLUDE NUTS OR ANY NUT PRODUCTS IN YOUR CHILD'S LUNCHBOX THIS INCLUDES PEANUT BUTTER

Please pack a suitable size lunch that your child will be able to eat in the lunchtime period. Nursery staff sit with the children during lunch and encourage them to eat their sandwiches/savoury food first. Although this is encouraged, Nursery staff feel it is best for the children to choose what they would like to eat rather than eat nothing for lunch. Children may arrive for lunch at 11.40am and we ask parents to be punctual. Those children going home after lunch must only be collected at 12.25pm so staff can see the children out safely by 12.30pm as the afternoon session will be starting. A late fee will be charged if parents fail to collect their children on time.

Useful Tips

- Please cut grapes/cherry tomatoes into small pieces and **remove the stones** from any fruit i.e. Cherries, plums, peaches, apricots etc. 
- Ensure your child's name is on the **outside** of the lunchbox and on any small containers. Please also try to use containers that your child can open independently where possible. This will encourage development as well as independence. 
- Please do not send any glass bottles/jars.
- Please do not include any popcorn, seeds or seeded bread in your child's lunch. Most popcorn is not recommended for children under 5 as it represents a choking hazard as do seeds and seeded products. 
- Milk or water will be provided so there is no need to send a drink.
- Anything your child has not eaten will be left inside the lunchbox.
- Please avoid sweets or chocolate as we promote healthy eating at nursery. 
- Lunchboxes are to be put on the rack on arrival at nursery.
- The fees for lunches will be added to your fortnightly invoice. 
- We require 1 month's notice for any cancellation of lunches.
